Week Three - Freedom to be loved as God's Child

Monday ~ READ

READ Romans 8:14-16 and 35-39 in 3 different translations or paraphrases. Choose one as your preferred. *www.Biblegateway.com is a great place to view varied translations and paraphrases of Scripture

Tuesday ~ COPY

COPY Romans 8:14-16 and 35-39 in your preferred translation or paraphrase.

Wednesday ~ PONDER

PONDER Romans 8:14-16 and 35-39 using the following prompts...

- Verses 14-15 Because we are not condemned to the "law of sin and death," but now live according to the "law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus," we get to experience the freedom of being God's child! Verse 15 contrasts what we were, "slaves," to what we are now, "children of God." Make a list of the differences between a slave who serves in a family, compared to a loved child in that family.
- Verse 15 What kind of fears might a slave have? What kind of privileges might a loved child have?
- **Verse 15** The word "adoption" conveys a great love. Ponder the dynamics that might accompany a parent adopting a child. How do these dynamics convey a great love? Journal your thoughts.
- **Verse 16** Ponder verse 16 alongside verse 11, making note of how the change from slave to child takes place in our hearts. Journal your thoughts.
- Verses 35-39 These verses describe the love which we now freely live in as God's children. Read these rich words as a slave might read them with longing, and then read them again as a child might read them with knowing. After doing so, respond to your Father.

Thursday ~ PRAY

PRAY into the freedom that Romans 8:14-16 and 35-39 reveal. Use the following prompts to do so:

- PRAISE and THANK God that you are no longer bound in slavery, but that you are His loved child
- **EXPRESS** your gratefulness specifically to God for the freedoms you have as His child by using some of the lists you made in our Ponder section.
- TALK to God about the things that threaten to separate you from His love, and ASK the Holy Spirit to bear witness in your heart that nothing will.
- **DECLARE** your trust in the freedom of God's eternal love for you by reading verses 38-39 out loud to your Father, affirming its Truths in your heart.
- PRAY for someone you know who is still in slavery, and ASK God to draw them into adoption as His child.
