



PSALM 119:89-96 SECTION 12 STUDY PLAN

During this 2-week period, complete the 10 study plans below.

We suggest focusing on one study plan per day.

Use the days of margin as needed.



Day 1

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read Psalm 119:89-96 in the NASB. Read Psalm 119:89-96 in at least two other versions of Scripture. Make notes about word variations that catch your attention. Take a moment to journal your first impressions of Section 12.

MEMORIZE... Select which verses in this section you will memorize during this 2-week period. Get started.

Day 2

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Copy Psalm 119:89-96 in the NASB on the left side of your paper. Then, on the right-hand side, beside your copy of the NASB, copy Psalm 119:89-96 from another version of choice. Underline words that seem powerful to you in either version, and then journal thoughts and impressions as you compare the different ways they are expressed.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review. AND... also take time to review what you memorized in earlier Sections.

Day 3

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read through Psalm 119:89-96 and write down every statement which includes one of the variation titles of God's Word (ex. Verse 93 – *"I will never forget Your precepts"*). After doing so, in light of what these titles mean (see Psalm 119 Glossary), consider the distinctions of these statements and journal your thoughts and impressions.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review.

As you meditate on these verses, you will find something amazing, delightful, practical and revealing.

Day 4

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read and copy Psalm 119:89-91 from the NASB with a view toward seeing something amazing. After copying, make note of the 3 things referenced in verses 89-90. Also make note of how verse 91 groups those 3 things together by using the word, *"They."* Then, consider the following questions: Vs. 89, what does it mean for God's *"Word to be settled?"* Verse 90, what does it mean for God's *"faithfulness to continue throughout all generations?"* Verses 90, what does it mean for the earth to be *"established"* and to *"stand?"* Verse 91, why is the cause of all 3 of these things being established? Before answering the last question listed below, listen to the teaching clip found on SoundCloud at this link. (time stamp 17:44 to 21:28)

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review. AND... remember to review earlier Sections as well.

Day 5

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read and copy Psalm 119:92-93 from the NASB with a view toward seeing something delightful. After copying, make note of the differences between duty, discipline and delight? In verses 92 David indicates that delighting in the Law of God kept him alive as he waited on God. Remember that the Law of God contains His precepts, and in verse 93, David also indicates that God's precepts were actually what revived Him. So, make a list of some of God's precepts that you delight in, and make sure to consider why you delight in them? (If needed, find some of God's precepts listed on the back of this page) Can you also recall a time that verses 92-93 have been true for you? If so, journal about it and thank God for His Word that kept you alive! If not, journal about your desire to delight in God's Law, and ask Him to help you do so.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review.

Day 6

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read and copy Psalm 119:94-95 from the NASB with a view toward implementing something practical. In these verses, David says that he *“sought God’s precepts”* and that he *“diligently considered God’s testimonies.”* It is often in the testimonies of God that we will see the precepts of God shine most brightly, so it is in our best interest to diligently consider them. Doing so is a practical way to seek the precepts of God! So, pick one of God’s testimonies (we recommend Exodus 14, but any testimony of God is great) and go through it carefully verse by verse, diligently making note of the details you find. Also make note of the precepts of God that shine forth in His testimony. Then, journal a prayer to God in regard to what you saw.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review. AND... remember to review earlier Sections as well

Day 7

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Read and copy Psalm 119:96 from the NASB with a view toward something revealing. As we move through life, our human nature often drives us to continually be seeking something more... something better... something perfect. But what does David reveal here? Consider his words in verse 96 as a backdrop against the answers you give to the following questions: When thinking of the ultimate achievement, position, possession, or experience in this world, where does your mind go? After identifying those things that your mind goes toward, journal about the limitations of each of them. Then consider what the second half of verse 96 reveals. How should that revelation shape the way you live?

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review. AND... just a reminder, the earlier Sections need review too.

Day 8

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Watch the video we’ve titled, Psalm 119:89-96, AAB Section 12, taking notes as you do. After watching, give this section a title.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review.

Day 9

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Using the four steps shared during Introduction Week about praying Scripture, pray through Psalm 119:89-96 for yourself.

MEMORIZE... Review. Add. Review.

Day 10

MEET... with God through prayer.

MEDITATE... Using the four steps shared during Introduction Week about praying Scripture, pray through Psalm 119:89-96 for a family member or friend.

MEMORIZE... Review. Share the verses you have memorized in some way.

*Extra Suggestion for Study of Psalm 119

REVIEW... Section 1 and revisit the things God showed you through your meditation of it.
